- 3) sacraments of Commitment which are Marriage and Holy Orders.

The Rite of Reconciliation

- Confessing of sins
- The act of contrition asking for God's forgiveness, the words of absolution given by the priest and the penance that is given as a thanksgiving for God's forgiveness.
- The priest celebrates the Sacrament of Reconciliation in the person and place of Christ to bring his forgiveness to those who ask it.
