


The Loaves and Fishes






Big crowds followed Jesus wherever he went.







He and his disciples went across the lake on a boat.




But when they got to the other side, another huge crowd was waiting.




Jesus felt sorry for them and began teaching all about God.

"You can give them food," said Jesus to his disciples.





But there were 5000 men with women and children too!
They didn't have enough food or money to feed them all.




There was a boy in the crowd who had brought his own lunch.

There were five loaves and two fishes.






Jesus had the people sit down in groups of 50 and 100.




Jesus took the loaves and gave thanks to God. Then he broke them and gave them to his disciples.
