T: Can I explain why the woman wanted to see Jesus?

Jesus forgave someone who was sorry for what she had done (and she had done lots of things wrong). As Jesus' friends found it difficult to understand at first, he told them a story.

His story explained that if you forgive more, you are showing more love and are loved more!

If you only forgive someone a little bit, then you are only showing a bit of love.

Jesus told the woman that her faith had saved her.

She showed him love and she was forgiven for her sins.

TASK:

Were you surprised by what Jesus did? Were you surprised by what the woman did? Why do you think that the woman came to Jesus? Why do you think that Jesus forgave her?

Imagine that you were Simon (who later became St. Peter). What did you think about what you saw? What would you say to a friend later about what happened?

Answer the questions and try to write in full sentences that make sense on their own.

Reflection:

This story teaches us about Jesus' love and that he will always forgive us. Can you think of a time when you didn't want to forgive someone, but you did anyway? How did it make you feel afterwards? Do you prefer to forgive someone, or be forgiven yourself?
