

Computing Scheme of Work Unit 3.4 -Touch Typing

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Introduction

This unit of work uses 2Type and is designed to help the pupils learn the basics of quick and efficient typing.

Typing, as with handwriting, needs regular practice and although the unit will give the pupils a basic understanding regular and consistent practice is needed over the next 4 years to ensure typing skills develop. As well as the activities suggested in these plans there are numerous other activities for the pupils to access

As with handwriting, some pupils will find learning to type easier than others. For this reason, you may need to adapt the pace of the lessons.

2Type is designed to be used with a keyboard. The new version on 2Type will also work on mobile devices.

Lesson 1



Aims

- To introduce typing terminology.
- Understand the correct way to sit at the keyboard.
- To learn how to use the home, top and bottom row keys.

Success criteria

- To understand the names of the fingers.
- To understand what is meant by home, bottom, and top rows.
- Developed ability to touch type the home, bottom, and top rows.



Activities

- 1. Share the learning objectives and success criteria
- 2. Explain that over the next few weeks the pupils will be learning basic skills to make them quicker and more efficient typists.
- 3. Before the lesson, show pupils the posture tips and introduction to typing in 2Type. These can be found on the 2Type home screen. At the end of the unit planning (appendix 1) the key points have been made into posters that can be enlarged and displayed around the classroom.



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- 4. Over the course of the lesson the pupils will learn to type
 - Home row keys
 - Bottom row keys
 - Top row keys
- 5. You will need to show the pupils how to choose the correct file.
- 6. Timings for each activity all have a default but can be changed. It is important a child uses the same timings to ensure accuracy of keeping scores.
- 7. Stress to the pupils that they need to make sure they use the correct finger as indicated at the bottom of the screen.
- The pupils will work through the various activities home row, bottom row, and top row keys. Each of the activities is designed to be worked through a few times to develop skills. It is advised to split the lesson into 3 x 20-minute sections.

- 10. At the end of the lesson bring the class together. How many pupils found their score increased on their second go? What did they find difficult?
- 11. Encourage the pupils to log onto Purple Mash at home and practice the work from today. You may want to set a 2do. The more they practice then the quicker they will become.


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


HOME ROW KEYS



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


TOP ROW KEYS


